'Round The World Rotation Program For Private Music Program (Piano & Voice)

The 'Round The World Rotation Program is a comprehensive program developed by Lopez Studios, Inc. to allow students to experience every major genre of music while also allowing each student to realize their individual interest. This program promotes a well-rounded view of music as well as allows each student to excel in the area they have interest.

How It Works:

Upon admittance into our Private Music Program, first year students will be required to participate in the 'Round The World Rotation Program. Students will be exposed to 3 main genres of music within the year. While students will still be required to complete their level of curriculum, all music, history, repertoire pieces, and supplemental material will have special emphasis on the specific genre that is in session. After students have completed a full year rotation of the program they may then choose their genre of choice for subsequent semesters or they may repeat the 'Round The World Rotation. If students choose to select a specific genre of interest, they must stay with the selected genre for a full year of study.

'Round The World Rotations

(Classical Rotation)

Study of music from the Master Composers as well as journey through the Baroque, Classical, and Romantic periods of music. This rotation is longer to allow for Christmas/Holiday Music.

(Jazz Rotation)

Study of Jazz, Rhythm and Blues, Boogie, Marches, Big Band, and Ragtime to name a few. Students will study music from composers such as Scott Joplin to George Gershwin.

(Contemporary)

Study of contemporary music including Pop, Broadway, Gospel, Hymns, Contemporary Christian and 20th Century compositions.

****Adult students are not required to participate in the above rotations.***
